## TERMS OF COMPETITION

## 1. MANAGEMENT

1.1 The Malaysia – Malaysia International Junior Open (hereinafter referred to as the Championship) shall be managed by an Organizing Committee (hereinafter referred to as "The Tournament Committee") whose decisions in all matters relating to the Championship shall be final.

### 2. **VENUE AND DATE**

- 2.1 The Championship will be played over 54 holes at Tanjong Puteri Golf Resort (TPGR) on 29<sup>th</sup> 31<sup>st</sup> August 2025 or any other course deemed fit by The Tournament Committee.
- 2.2 Please note that category boys & girls (A and B) will be playing at Plantation Course (A course) Tanjong Puteri Golf Resort 3 rounds Event.
  For category Boys & Girls (C & D) will be competing at Straits Course (C course)
- 2.3 Additional, please note that for category:
  - Category special will play 3 rounds of 18-hole each
  - Boys & Girls A & B will play 3 rounds of 18-hole each, and
  - Boys & Girls C & D will play 3 rounds of 18-hole each.



















## 3. **SCHEDULE OF PLAY**

3.1 The schedule of the play shall be as follows:

## Practice Round 28 August 2025 (Thursday)

- Registration & Official Practice Round for all Category

### Round 1, 29th August 2025 (Friday)

- First Round (Special, Boys & Girls A & B category)
- First Round (Boys & Girls C and D category)

### Round 2, 30th August 2025 (Saturday)

- Second Round (Special, Boys & Girls A & B category)
- Second Round (Boys & Girls C and D category)

### Final Round, 31st August 2025 (Sunday)

- Final Round (Special, Boys & Girls A & B category)
- Final round (Boys & Girls C and D category)
- Prize Presentation Lunch

### 4. **FORMAT OF PLAY**

- 4.1 The tournament shall be decided by Stroke play over 3 rounds of 18 holes each day, subject to The Tournament Committee's right in the event of circumstances which make the playing of 54 holes impracticable, to cancel any round or rounds at its discretion
- 4.2 There shall be NO **Cut Off**

















- 4.3 Distance of Play
- 4.3.1 Please be informed only category BA, BB, GA, GB will be entitled for the WAGR point.

## 5. **ELIGIBILITY**

- 5.1 The Tournament is open to Boy & Girl players who are:
  - (a) All participants must be aged between 6 and 23 years old as of August 2025, based on their month and year of birth.
  - (b) Only individuals born between 1st September 2001 and 31st August 2019 (inclusive) are eligible to participate in this competition.
  - (c) Proof of date of birth (such as an identification card, birth certificate, or passport) must be provided during registration or upon request by the organizing committee.
  - (d) Amateur Golfers in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by the R&A Rules Limited.
  - (e) Having a maximum WHS Handicap Index of 17.2 Men and below and 17.5 Ladies and below at the time of entry will be applicable throughout the Championship.
  - (f) Member of a Club affiliated to Malaysian Golf Association (MGA) with similar handicap indices.
  - (g) Category C and D no need handicap index but if they do have please state.
- 5.2 The Tournament Committee reserves the right to reject any entry without giving any reason.
- 5.3 The Organizing Committee may, as its discretion, accept entry of player/s with higher handicap or without the WHS index at its discretion but it must be certified by either the club Captain, or club Manager or coach.

The entry fee is RM600.00 nett (Category Special, A,B,C&D) (Malaysian) and RM850.00 nett (Category Special, A,B,C&D) (Non-Malaysian) — excluding bank charges) per player. This fee is inclusive of 3 rounds for category A&B and category C&D days round of golf competition, daily golf insurance, lunch on the prize giving.

Those unable to register within the stipulated times may be accepted at the discretion of The Committee. **Entry forms** without the accompanying payment will **NOT** be accepted.

Entry fee includes 3 days of golf competition, prize giving lunch and goodies.



















6.3 The field shall be limited to 120 competitors (Category Special, A&B) and 80 competitors (Category C&D) on a first come first serve basis. If entries fall short or exceed the number, The Tournament Committee reserves the right to make amendments to the entry requirements without giving any reason whatsoever.

## 7. WITHDRAWAL

7.1 The entry fee will not be refunded if any competitors withdraw from the tournament and the withdrawal is made after 5.00 p.m. on 11th August 2025 (Monday)

### 8. **REGISTRATION**

8.1 All competitors are required to register in person or by telephone by 1.00 p.m. on 25 August 2025. Failure to do so may result in the competitor being withdrawn from the Championship with no refund of any fees paid.

## 9. RULES OF PLAY

9.1 Rules of play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited, the local Rules of the Tanjong Puteri Golf Resort and any additional local rules as approved by The Tournament Committee.

### 10. **PRACTICE ROUND**

10.1 Official practice round is on 28th August 2025 (Thursday) from 7.30 am onwards.

All players must leave the course by 4.00PM

- For Category Special, A and B will be playing at Plantation Course



















- Buggy Fee (twin sharing) is **RM 108** per buggy is compulsory. All golfers must ride golf carts in pairs if applicable. Additional **RM 37.80** after tax for single rider.
- The club will assign the players, if only I player at one time, to another group to make sure there is no single rider during the practice round.
- Category C and D will be playing at C course (Straits Course)
   Buggy Fee (twin sharing) is RM 108 per buggy are compulsory. All golfers must ride golf carts in pairs if applicable. Additional RM37.80 after tax for single rider.
- Please note that parents who insist to be caddie need to pay rm20 per day for insurance. Please make the booking (compulsory) for the tee time directly with the golf club in advance. Additionally, for followers need to pay the followers pass at RM60 for 3 days

### 11. DRAWS & STARTING TIMES

- 11.1 Player shall be in groups of three (3) or four (4) competitors at 10/9 minutes interval.
- 11.2 The Tournament Committee will decide the draw and the starting time for the first two rounds. The draw for the final round will be arranged according to the first 2 rounds scores; the lowest scores will tee off last from the first tee and the highest scores will tee off last from the tenth tee.
- 11.3 The draws and starting times shall be posted at the Tournament Notice Board. Such posting shall be considered sufficient notice for information and distribution.



















11.4 The player shall start at the time laid down by the Tournament Committee. If a player arrives at his starting point ready to play within five minutes after his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time shall be two strokes at the starting hole (Rule 5.3a). Otherwise, the penalty for breach of these rules shall be **DISQUALIFICATION**.

"Exception: Where the Committee determines that exceptional circumstances have prevented a player from starting on time, there is no penalty."

11.5 The Tournament Committee reserves the right to change the draws and vary the starting times without giving any reason thereof.

## 12. PACE OF PLAY (Rule 5.6)

## **Time Allowed**

12.1 Each hole has been given a maximum completion time based upon the length and difficulty of the hole. The maximum time allotted for the completion of 18 holes will be available prior to play.

### **Definition of Out of Position**

12.2 The first group and any group after a starter's gap wille considered to be "out of position" if at any time during the round, the group's cumulative time exceeds the time allowed for the number of holes played. Any following group will be considered "out of position" if it is more than the starting time interval behind the group in front and has exceeded the time allowed for the number of the holes played.



















## **Procedure When Group Is Out of Position**

- 12.3. If the decision is taken to time the group, each player in the group will be subject to individual timing by a Referee. Each player in the group will be advised that they are "out of position" and are being timed.
- 12.4 The maximum time allocated per shot is 40 seconds. 10 extra seconds are allowed for the first player to play:
  - On the tee box
  - On the subsequent shots: and
  - On the putting green
- 12.5 The timing will start when a player has reached his ball, it is his turn to play and he is able to play without interference or distraction. On putting green, timing will start when the player has had a reasonable amount of time to lift, clean and replaced his ball, repair ball marks and move loose impediments on his line of putt. Time spent looking at the line from beyond the hole and/ or behind the ball will count as time taken for the next stroke.
- 12.6 Timing ceases when a group is either back in position in relation to the preceding group or within the allocated time for the holes played.

### PENALTY OF BREACH OF CONDITION

1 bad time Player will be warned by the Rules Official and told that if

he has a further bad time he will be penalized.

**STROKEPLAY** 

2 bad times Penalty of one stroke



















3 bad times Further penalty of two strokes

4 bad times Disqualification

12.7 If a group is "out of position" more than once during a round, the above procedure will apply on each occasion. Bad times and the applications of penalties in the same round will be carried forward until the Round is completed. A player will not be penaltized if he has a second bad time before being advised of his earlier bad time

## 13. USE OF MOTORIZED TRANSPORTATION & CADDIE

- 13.1 All players will be provided with a buggy on TWIN SHARING basis during the stipulated. round.
- 13.2 The use of caddies is allowed only for group C & D categories only.
- 13.3 Parent/coach/guardian/ is allowed to serve as caddies for players playing in C & D categories but must be pre-registered with the club, must possess valid insurance and Pass. Pass will be given after paying the insurance. RM20 x 1 day

#### 14. APPROVED EQUIPMENT

14.1 Golf Balls (Rule 4.2a)

Balls Allowed in Play of Round

(1) Conforming Ball Must Be Played. In making each stroke, a player must use a ball that conforms to the requirements in the Equipment Rules.



















A player may get a conforming ball to play from anyone else, including another player on the course.

(2) Deliberately Altered Ball Must Not Be Played. A player must not make a stroke at a ball whose performance characteristics have been deliberately altered, such as by scuffing or heating the ball or by applying any substance (other than in cleaning it).

### 14.2 Equipment (Rule 4.3a)

#### **Allowed and Prohibited Uses**

A player may use equipment to help his or her play during a round, except that a player must not create a potential advantage by:

- 1) Using equipment (other than a club or a ball) that artificially eliminates or reduces the need for a skill or judgment that is essential to the challenge of the game, or
- Using equipment (including a club or a ball) in an abnormal way in making a stroke. "Abnormal way" means a way that is fundamentally different than its intended use and is not normally recognized as part of playing the game.

This Rule does not affect the application of any other Rule that limits actions a player is allowed to take with a club, ball or other equipment (such as setting down a club or other object to help the player in lining up, see Rule 10.2b(3)).

#### PENALTY: DISQUALIFICATION

















## 15. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE (DMD)

Player are ALLOWED TO USE distance measuring device (DMD) to obtain distance

Player must turn off the slope and elevation function on the device and strictly

Comply to R&A rules 4.3a

## 16. **SCORECARDS**

- 16.1 All competitors must submit their respective scorecard duly signed and counter signed by his/her marker as soon as possible after the completion of each round and in any event, it shall not be later than <u>10 minutes</u> after the completion of each round.
- 16.2 A scorecard is deemed to be submitted the moment the competitor leaves the scoring area with two both feet.

#### 17. PRIZES

### 17.1 a. The Gross Champion (Boys)

The competitor who returns the lowest aggregate gross score over 54 holes or less shall be declared as The Champion.

#### b) Prizes will be awarded as follows:

 $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$  placing + medals category gross scores over 54 holes or less.

#### 17.2 a) The Gross Champion (Girls)

The competitor who returns the lowest aggregate gross score over 54 holes or less shall be declared as The Champion.



















## b) Prizes will be awarded as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> placing + medals category gross scores over 54 holes or less.

## 17.3 a) Category (Boys and Girls)

It will be four categories for each division and will be awarded 3 prizes each category.

The category as below:

Category special – 19 – 23 years old

Category BA & GA – 15-18 years old

Category BB & GB – 13-14 years old

Category BC & GC-11-12 years old

Category BD & GD - 9 years old and below

NOTE: Number of prizes may be changed depending on the final entries.

### 18. **COMPETITION CLOSED**

18.1 The Championship shall be deemed to have closed when the prizes have been awarded to the winners.

#### 19. **TIES**

19.1 In the event of a tie for Overall Boys & Girls Gross category the first place, the winner shall be decided by a sudden death playoff on the hole to be decided by the Committee until the winner is decided by elimination. The purpose of the playoff is to decide the WINNER for the championship only.



















- 19.2 In the event of a tie for any other places, the tie shall be decided by a count-back on the score card in the following order:
  - I. Last 18 holes (Final Round)
  - II. Last 9 holes (holes 10 18) of Final Round
  - III. Last 6 holes (holes 13 18) of Final Round
  - IV. Last 3 holes (holes 15 18) of Final Round
  - V. And finally, the last hole (hole 18) of Final Round
  - VI. If the tie is still undecided, it shall be decided by lot.

## 20. **DECISIONS**

20.1 If the Committee has appointed a Referee, his/her decision is final (Rule 20.2a). In the absence of a Referee, any dispute or doubtful point on the Rules shall be referred to the Committee, whose decision shall be final (Rule 20.2b).

## 21. **DISPUTES AND APPEAL**

- 21.1 Any disputes that arise during the tournament must be put forward to the Appeal Committee as soon as practicable upon completion of a round and in any event, it shall not be later than 15 minutes after completion of the said round.
- 21.2 A penalty of disqualification may in exceptional cases be waived, modified or imposed by the Tournament Appeal Committee.



















## 22. STANDARDS OF PLAYER CONDUCT

- 22.1 The following may be considered serious breach of Standards of Player Conduct (Rule 1.2):
  - (a) Usage of hand phone during a round to the annoyance and distractions of other players.
  - (b) Verbal abuse of fellow competitor/official/staff.
  - (c) Intentionally distracting or offending fellow competitors.
  - (d) Consuming alcoholic drinks during play.
  - (e) Any other breaches not listed above but are deemed to be serious by the Committee

Exception: Players may use hand phone in case of buggy breakdown or injury/illness of players.

#### PENALTY FOR BREACH OF THIS LOCAL RULE:

First breach : 1 stroke penalty
Second breach : 2 strokes penalty
Third breach : Disqualification

### 23. **ANTI-DOPPING**

23.1 Players must not make use of any drug to enhance performance. Should a player show evidence of use of drug for non-therapeutic purposes, the Committee may require the player to undergo a drug test. Any player infringing this Term may be disqualified. Players who are on medication and in doubt as to their clinical status should seek advice from the R&A via the Tournament Office.

















### 24. INCLEMENT WEATHER AND SUSPENSION OF PLAY

24.1 The Tournament Committee will make every effort to complete the event in its entirety. However, The Tournament Committee reserves the right to suspend, or abandon play as and when necessary if weather-related circumstances require such action. The Tournament Committee will inform all competitors accordingly.

## 25. CAPTURE AND USE OF IMAGES

- 25.1 Participants may be filmed and photographed and may film and photograph during the championship.
- 25.2 By signing the entry form, participant agree to be filmed, photographed, televised or otherwise recorded during the championship, and that captured or recorded image, together with the name, may be used in any content, format and through any media or technology whether now existing or created in the future, by the organizing committee, and third parties authorized by the organizing committee during or after the championship in perpetuity in relation to the celebration and promotion of the game of golf in a non-commercial manner.

## 26. **INDEMINITY/LIABILITIES**

26.1 MGA, the Sponsors, The Tournament Committee, the Golf Club and their staff will not be responsible for any loss, damage or harm, or any form of injuries that the participants may suffer because of their participation in this tournament
